2015 MCM Topics

APRIL: Disaster Preparedness

This seminar will focus on the Emergency Preparedness Plan each park is required to have in place pursuant to the Health and Safety Code. In addition, discussion will focus on when and how to communicate with the media following an emergency/disaster at your park, as well as practical responses to various unforseen emergency/disaster situations related to your park and business.

MAY: Technology and Tenancy

This seminar will focus on the emerging business trend to move more to technology and e-documents in the operational practices of your park and how they affect your relationships and requirements as related to tenancy. In addition, WMA's Forms Online program will be highlighted.

AUGUST: Mental Health First Aid

This seminar will provide training by a mental health professional on the warning signs and potential risk factors for a range of mental health problems and will include development of an action plan, appropriate for a general layperson, encompassing skills, resources and knowledge to assess potentially difficult situations and the appropriate course of action to ensure safety.
